

Charity Gift Aid Declaration

Gift Aid Declaration – guidance notes for completion

Your Society is a member of The Arts Society (The National Association of Decorative and Fine Art Societies), which is a registered charity (registered charity number of England and Wales 1089743).

The Arts Society is able to claim Gift Aid on the affiliation fee (donation) paid by you as part of your total annual subscription.

Your subscription including the affiliation fee will be collected by your Society in the usual way.

If you are a higher rate taxpayer, you can also claim back the difference between the standard and higher rates of tax in your self-assessment tax return.

The claim can be back dated to cover donations from 1 January 2014.

If you wish for your previous donations via the affiliation fee to be included, please ensure that you leave that option on the form open.
